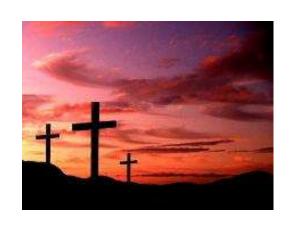


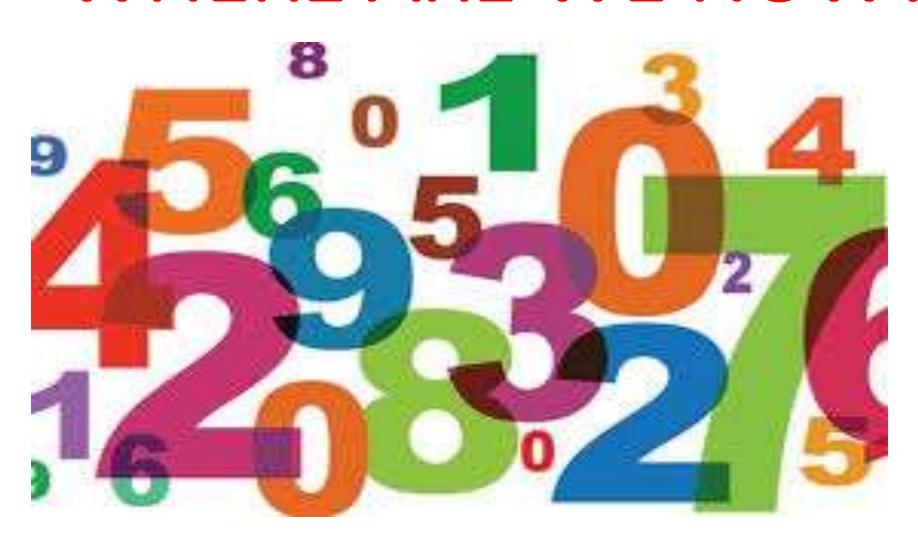

Considerations from the Pastoral Planning Steering Committee in Selecting New Church Home

St Justin Church

- · Architecture of building is Art deco
- All four structures on property are occupied
- (Parish Center, Rectory, Church, school rental property)
- Rectory in good condition, could comfortable housed more priests
- Parish center and school generate income
- Beautiful stained glass windows and organ
- Handi-cap access
- · Food pantry has 140 client's weekly
- Majority of parishioners live in close proximity of the church. Some walk to Mass
- Current weekly offertory is more than SM (11/2016)
- Total registered households are higher than SM
- More secured parking
- Currently the Parish offices/address is located at SJ
- Parish Center serves multiple purposes including a Retreat Center
- Income potential from Jubilee Hall
- Historically recognized church as first in US to use American Perpendicular style. Visited by college students and design students
- Organ is registered with the National Society of Historical Organs and has appeared in numerous magazines
- Has in the past been the site for Concora Organ recitals
- Receive income from the rental School property
- One of few churches in the country to successfully combine religion and architecture

St Michael Church

- Smaller thereby easier to maintain which would cost less
- Fewer stairs inside the church for parishioners to navigate
- Acoustics are better
- Location in a "distressed" area of the city which will benefit from Evangelization
- Need for a church home/family in the community is greater
- Operating budget is less expensive
- More efficient building: heating, electricity and repairs have been minor
- Income from buildings it owns
- Softer pews
- Can use school parking for overflow
- Size of church is more conducive to "one" church family

Kitchen facilities more modern for cooking (Thanksgiving dinner, fund raisers, cookouts

- 7. Mass Schedule: 8:30a (Traditional), 10A (Gospel), 12N(Spanish), 4P(Creole)
